## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Small Things Country Creatures Collection)

Note: all three quilts are made up the same way, only the sashing strips are different colours
Fabric 1: long $1 / 4$ - ASM11.1 (Deer grey)
Fabric 2: $3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-30 \mathrm{~cm}-$ ASM11.2 (Deer sage)
Fabric 3: 3/8yd - 30cm - ASM11.3 (Deer red)
Fabric 4: long $1 / 4-$ ASM12.1 (Fox natural)
Fabric 5: long $1 / 4-$ ASM12.2 (Fox brown)
Fabric 6: long $1 / 4$ - ASM12.3 (Fox charcoal)
Fabric 7: long $1 / 4-$ ASM13.1 (Mice cream)
Fabric 8: long $1 / 4-$ ASM13.2 (Mice hay)
Fabric 9: long $1 / 4-$ ASM13.3 (Mice claret)
Fabric 10: long $1 / 4$ - ASM14.1 (Hedgehog cream)
Fabric 11: long $1 / 4$ - ASM14.2 (Hedgehog grey)
Fabric 12: long $1 / 4$ - ASM14.3 (Hedgehog warm lavender)
Fabric 13: long $1 / 4$ - ASM15.1 (Otter light blue)
Fabric 14: long $1 / 4$ - ASM15.2 (Otter dusky blue)
Fabric 15: long $1 / 4$ - ASM15.3 (Otter black)
Fabric 16: 1yd - 1mtr - BB20 (Black) for quilt design 1 sashing Fabric 17: 1yd - 1mtr - BB94 (Light grey) for quilt design 2 sashing
Fabric 18: 1yd - 1mtr - BB154 (Emerald) for quilt design 3 sashing
Wadding and backing 53" x 60"
All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go

## CUTTING

1. From fabrics $1,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14$ and 15 cut:
(9x) $41 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
2. From each of the fabrics 2 and 3 cut:
( $2 x$ ) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26 \frac{1}{2}$ " (side borders)
(2x) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 25^{\prime \prime}$ (top and bottom borders)
3. From fabric 16 for quilt design 1 cut:
(121x) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{"}$ sashing strips
4. From fabric 17 for quilt design 2 cut:
(121x) $11 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2$ " sashing strips
5. From fabric 18 for quilt design 3 cut:
(121x) $11 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2$ " sashing strips

## MAKING UP THE QUILT

Lay out your fabric pieces for each of the rows as in the Main Diagram, with the sashing in between each of the fabric squares as in Figure 1. Sew the squares and sashing strips together along the row. Repeat for each of the rows

Now sew the rows together to complete the quilt top, alternating the layout of the rows as in the Main Diagram and Figure 2

Border
Stitch your side strips together as in the Main Diagram and then sew to each side of the quilt
Next join the top and bottom strips together and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt
Your quilt top is complete

## Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired Trim backing and wadding to size

## Binding

Use your favourite method from the leftover sashing fabric to bind the quilt
